

This illustration depicts the Ontario Regiment's commanding officer's tank, 'SUN CHARIOT', named after a famous racehorse of the period. The name was painted in white on the side of the hull, together with an AFV recognition sign and the tank's census number. The positioning of the markings varied from vehicle to vehicle as evidenced by wartime photographs. The red diamond shaped tac sign on the turret side indicated that this was a tank of the regimental headquarters of the senior regiment of the brigade.
